

RESOLUTION NO.: 25 -2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE NEW CASE CONSTRUCTION ARTICULATED WHEEL LOADER FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE.

WHEREAS, Council has previously authorized cooperative purchasing through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchase Program and the Charter of the City authorizes such purchases;

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has advised this Council that the Department of Public Service is in need of a new wheel loader; and has obtained a quote from Southeastern Equipment Company for a new Case Construction Model 621G articulated wheel loader at a cost of \$164,626.56, which is at or below the Ohio Department of Administrative Services' state term schedule government pricing under Contract No. 800585;

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Finance Committees have reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommends the same to Council, and Council desires to authorize the purchase of a new Case Construction Model 621G articulated wheel loader from Southeastern Equipment Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Southeastern Equipment Company for a new Case Construction Model 621G articulated wheel loader for an amount not to exceed \$164,626.56.


Section 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate from the Local Fiscal Recovery-ARPA Fund a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase agreement authorized in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


