

RESOLUTION NO.: 17 -2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HEALTH AND FITNESS EQUIPMENT CENTERS FOR THE PURCHASE OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE AND TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 64-2021, passed by Council on June 22, 2021, the City accepted a U.S. Department of Homeland Security "Assistance to Firefighters Grant" (the "Grant") in the amount of \$39,104, consisting of a ninety-five percent (95%) value of \$37,241.90 and a five percent (5%) match by the City of \$1,862.10, for the purpose of developing a fitness and injury prevention program in the Division of Fire; including the purchase of fitness equipment, peer fitness trainer certification, and staffing expenses;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Fire has received a quote from Health and Fitness Equipment Centers for the purchase of fitness equipment in an amount not to exceed twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000.00), which was the lowest of nine quotes;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to expend Grant funds and enter into a purchase agreement with Health and Fitness Equipment Centers, 35665 Curtis Blvd., Eastlake Ohio 44095, for the purchase of fitness equipment for the Division of Fire at a cost not to exceed \$23,000.00, in accordance with the quote from Health and Fitness Equipment Centers attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase agreement in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


