

RESOLUTION NO.: 34 -2022

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE ACTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO THE CONDITIONAL APPROVAL OF AN ATHLETIC ACTIVITY FACILITY AT 26361 CURTIS WRIGHT PARKWAY, BUILDING A-E.

Whereas, the Planning Commission at its regular meeting on March 9, 2022, passed a motion to recommend to Council the conditional approval of an application for an athletic activity facility in an I-1 Office-Industrial District as an "Other Use", pursuant to Zoning Code Section 1167.03, the application for which was submitted by Go 428 Athletics LLC for the use to be at 26361 Curtis Wright Parkway, Building A-E, and with the condition being that the applicant must submit a parking plan that is in compliance with the Zoning Code requirements;

Whereas, the Planning and Zoning Committee of Council at its April 5, 2022 meeting recommended confirmation of the Planning Commission's actions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The actions of the Planning Commission taken at its March 9, 2022 regular meeting recommending to Council the approval of an application for an athletic activity facility in an I-1 Office-Industrial District as an "Other Use", pursuant to Zoning Code Section 1167.03, which was submitted by Go 428 Athletics LLC for the use to be at 26361 Curtis Wright Parkway, Building A-E, is hereby confirmed with the condition that the applicant must submit to the Building Commissioner a parking plan that is in compliance with the Zoning Code requirements.

Section 2: This Council finds that this application is related to and reasonably necessary and convenient for the satisfactory and efficient operation of a complete and integrated Office Industrial District; and if is similar in character to one or more of the uses permitted by Zoning Code Section 1167.02.


