A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN AUTOLUBE SYSTEM AND EXTENDED WARRANTY FOR A FRONT WHEEL LOADER FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has advised this Council that the Department of Public Service is in need of a Lubecore Midwest Autolube System for its Case Model 621G Articulated Wheel Loader;

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has received a quotation from Southeastern Equipment Company for the provision of one (1) Lubecore Midwest Autolube System with extended warranty for the cost of \$10,400.00;

WHEREAS, Council's Committees have reviewed the need for this purchase and recommend the same to Council with the funds coming from the City's "Local Fiscal Recovery Fund" that this Council created to deposit the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) funds.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Southeastern Equipment Company, 8757 Tyler Blvd., Mentor, Ohio 44060, for the provision of one (1) Lubecore Midwest Autolube System with extended warranty, as quoted, for a total cost not to exceed \$10,400.00 coming from the Local Fiscal Recovery Fund.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
