**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 101-2021 TO INCREASE THE CONTRACT AMOUNT FOR ADDITIONAL WORK ON THE PATH RENOVATION PROJECT USING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 101-2021, adopted by this Council on September 28, 2021, the Council authorized a contract with Ohio Paving & Construction Co., Inc. to perform the Path Renovation Project for the restoration of the walking trails at Richmond Heights Community Park and on the east side of Richmond Road along the Cuyahoga County Airport for an amount not to exceed \$116,333.50 which is to be paid from a Community Development Block Grant of \$150,000.00;

WHEREAS, there is a need for additional work on the Path Renovation Project to extend the path which will require use of the full amount of the grant funds of \$150,000, as well as a matching amount from the City.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

Section 1. Resolution No. 101-2021 of this Council is amended to authorize the cost of the contract with Ohio Paving & Construction Co, Inc. to perform additional work on the Path Renovation Project, as set forth in the recitals to this Resolution, to be increased to an amount not to exceed \$155,000.00, with \$5,000.00 of that amount as a contingency on the contract.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
