

RESOLUTION NO.: 57-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CivicPlus, LLC FOR A NEW UPDATED CITY WEBSITE.

WHEREAS, in order to better serve the citizens of Richmond Heights and to secure the website from hackers, the Mayor has investigated vendors to provide a new updated website for the City, has obtained quotations of cost for this service, and recommends the City enter into an agreement with CivicPlus, LLC which has impressive qualifications and provides website services to local governments, including local governments in Ohio;

Whereas, the City's current website is very limited in its applications, is difficult to use for posting public information, and is subject to security breaches, all of which warrants the City obtaining a new website.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with CivicEdge for a total cost for the initial year of construction and service of the website of \$24,999 to come from the Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, which agreement shall be acceptable to the Mayor and approved as to legal form and correctness by the Director of Law.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to expend funds from the Local Fiscal Recovery Fund in the amount deemed necessary to cover the cost for the purchase of the services as set forth in Section 1 above.

Section 3: Subject to an annual appropriation of funds by this Council, the Mayor is authorized to agree with CivicPlus, LLC to an annual service fee of \$4,725 for a second year of service from CivicPlus, LLC.


Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 5: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
