

RESOLUTION NO: 60 -2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO RENEW THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS MEMBERSHIP IN THE COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP ON AGING FOR OLDER ADULT SERVICES AND TO PAY THE MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL FEE FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022.

WHEREAS, Community Partnership on Aging (“CPA”) is a nonprofit social service agency that has been in existence since 1978 and provides programs and services to support the independence, community involvement and wellbeing of older adults in the Hillcrest area through an agreement with a regional council of governments under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 167 that currently includes as members the local municipalities of: South Euclid, Lyndhurst, Highland Heights, Mayfield Heights, Mayfield Village, and Richmond Heights (the “COG”);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 13-2020, this Council authorized the City of Richmond Heights to be a member of the COG and to receive the services of CPA;

WHEREAS, approximately one-third of the population of Richmond Heights is over age 60 and another third of the population is between ages 39 to 59, creating a steady stream of persons into the over age 60 category and whose needs for support often increase with aging;

WHEREAS, this Council supports the City’s continued full membership in the COG and the payment of the annual membership fee for 2022 as furthering the health, safety and general welfare of its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council authorizes the payment of the fee for the City of Richmond Heights to maintain its full membership in the regional council of governments as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution in order to participate in the Community Partnership on Aging’s services for calendar year 2022 in the amount of \$81,854.00.


Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
