A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NORTHCOAST SIGNWORKS FOR THE PURCHASE OF TEN NEW CITY ENTRANCE SIGNS.

WHEREAS, the Service Director of Public Services has advised this Council that the City is in need of ten (10) new, updated City entrance signs for various locations;

WHEREAS, the City has received a quotation, dated April 26, 2022, from Northcoast Signworks to provide ten (10) new single-sided City signs with Mayor's plaque and architectural posts for a cost not to exceed \$24,738.68;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Northcoast Signworks for the purchase of ten (10) new single-sided City signs with Mayor's plaque and architectural posts in an amount not to exceed \$24,738.68.

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.
