**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE  
EXISTING CONTRACT WITH SPECIALIZED CONSTRUCTION, INC.  
FOR NECESSARY ADDITIONAL ROAD PAINT STRIPING WORK FOR  
CITY STREETS IN 2022.**

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has recommended, and this Council has determined, that all public roads and streets within the municipal boundaries are in need of new paint striping in 2022 and there is an existing competitively bid and awarded contract that was entered into in 2021, pursuant to Council Resolution No. 76-2021, between the City and Specialized Construction, Inc. which included this same type of work;

WHEREAS, Specialized Construction, Inc. has agreed to perform the additional road paint striping at the same quantity pricing as is in the competitively bid contract with the City from 2021;

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has estimated the cost of the road paint striping for all public roads and streets in the City will be \$125,000, based on Specialized's 2021 competitively bid quantity prices and which amount will form the basis for a change order to the 2021 contract with Specialized for this additional work;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Based upon the statements in the recitals to this Resolution, a change order to the 2021 contract with Specialized Construction, Inc. that was authorized by this Council's Resolution No. 76-2021, is hereby approved for additional road paint striping work for all public roads and streets within the City corporate limits in an amount not to exceed \$125,000, and the Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to execute said change order.

Section 2: To the extent it is necessary to do so, the Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account the funds needed for the change order authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
