

RESOLUTION NO.: 70-2022
INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Thomas

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE SIX (6) COMPUTERS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FROM THE APPLE STORE FOR CITY DEPARTMENTAL AND SPECIAL EVENT USE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has advised this Council that the City is in need of six (6) computers and two (2) mouses to replace the ones currently in use by the Economic Development Office, the Recreation Department, the Human Resources Office, and for special events;

WHEREAS, the Mayor has determined that the necessary computers and mouses may be purchased from the Apple Store and that two (2) 13-inch MacBook Pro – Space Gray models may be purchased for the amount of \$3,798.00, that four (4) 24-inch Blue iMac with 4.5K retina display models may be purchased for the amount of \$8,912.00, and that two (2) Magic Mouse – Black Multi-Touch Surface models may be purchased for \$198.00 for a total cost not to exceed \$14,000.00;

WHEREAS, it is requested that the funds for this purchase come from the City's "Local Fiscal Recovery Fund" that this Council created to deposit the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 ("ARPA") funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with the Apple Store for the purchase of the necessary computers and mouses, as described in the recitals above, at a total cost not to exceed Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00), coming from the Local Fiscal Recovery Fund.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




