A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH JOHNSON CONTROLS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF VARIOUS SECURITY SYSTEMS FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor previously entered into a one-year agreement with Johnson Controls for the ongoing maintenance of certain security systems for the Division of Police and Johnson Controls has offered to renew the agreement for one year for the amount of Seven Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$7,657.25);

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into a renewal agreement with Johnson Controls as described above.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into the renewal agreement with Johnson Controls for services described in the recitals of this Resolution for a cost not to exceed Seven Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$7,657.25).


