

ORDINANCE NO: 42 -2022

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING THE GREENWOOD FARM PROPERTY AS
A MUNICIPAL PUBLIC PARK.

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights, pursuant to Article III, Section 2 of its Charter, has all the powers vested in an elective council which may now or hereafter be lawfully possessed or exercised by municipalities under the laws of Ohio, including the power of its legislative authority, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 755.12, to designate and set apart for use as parks any lands owned by the City and not dedicated or devoted to other public use;

WHEREAS, upon the consideration and recommendation by the Planning Commission of a proposal to dedicate for use as a municipal public park the City-owned property known as the Greenwood Farm property (Permanent Tax Parcel Nos. 661-08-005, 661-08-040, and 661-08-042), this Council desires to dedicate said property for use as a municipal public park;


NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council determines that the City-owned property known as the Greenwood Farm property, Permanent Parcel Nos. 661-08-005, 661-08-040, and 661-08-042, consisting of a total of approximately 16.35 acres, not dedicated or devoted to other public use, shall be designated and set apart for use as a municipal public park.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.
