RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SHALLOW CREEK KENNELS INC. FOR THE TRAINING OF A CANINE FOR NARCOTICS DETECTION AND POLICE PATROL SERVICE DOG PURPOSES FOR THE CITY'S DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor/Director of Public Safety and the Chief of Police recommend the procurement of professional canine training services for the training of one (1) canine that will be used by the City's Division of Police for the purposes of narcotics detection and police patrol service dog services;

WHEREAS, the City administration has obtained a quote for the aforesaid professional services from Shallow Creek Kennels Inc. in the amount of \$14,500 for the training of one (1) canine and one (1) police handler and determined this company is well-recommended to provide the within services;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to execute a contractual agreement with Shallow Creek Kennels Inc. for professional canine and handler training services for one (1) canine and one (1) police handler in an amount not to exceed Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$14,500.00) and under such other terms and conditions as determined to be reasonable by the Mayor/Director of Public Safety and the Chief of Police and in proper legal form as determined by the Director of Law.

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the agreement referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting or meetings of this Council, that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements, including, without limitation, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


