

RESOLUTION NO.: 55-2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ALL AMERICAN FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF HYDRAULIC RESCUE TOOLS AND AIRBAG EQUIPMENT FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Fire has advised this Council that the Division of Fire is in need of battery powered hydraulic rescue tools and airbag equipment for the Division of Fire;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Fire has received a bid from All American Fire Equipment for the purchase of battery powered hydraulic rescue tools and airbag equipment in an amount not to exceed \$35,808.00, which was the lowest of two bids;

WHEREAS, the City has received a U.S. Department of Homeland Security "Assistance to Firefighters Grant" in the amount of \$49,700 for this purchase and which grant requires a 5% matching funds amount of \$2,366.67 which will be paid by Cuyahoga County Public Safety & Justice Services, thereby not requiring any expenditure of City funds for this equipment;

WHEREAS, Council's Safety Committee and Finance Committee have reviewed the need for this purchase and recommend the same to Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with All American Fire Equipment, 5101 US Highway 22 SW, Washington CH, Ohio 43160, for the purchase of battery powered hydraulic rescue tools and airbag equipment, as set forth above, for a total cost not to exceed \$35,808.00.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
