

RESOLUTION NO.: 120 -2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE CUYAHOGA SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT FOR THE PROVISION OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE IN IMPLEMENTING SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES.

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District County (“SWCD”) can provide services required by the City’s Stormwater Management Plan to the City of Richmond Heights and has offered to do so by Memorandum of Understanding in years 2021 through 2025 (the “MOU”);

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (“NEORSD”) is required to provide Phase II stormwater regulation support services to member communities for Minimum Control Measure Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 6 under NEORSD’s Regional Stormwater Management Code (Title V), and is further authorized to provide such services through agreements with service providers such SWCD;

WHEREAS, the MOU by and between the City, SWCD and NEORSD will provide services for the implementation of conservation education, stewardship, and public involvement activities that also corresponds to the City’s Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit requirements (the “Services”);

WHEREAS, this Council believes it is in the best interest of the City to enter into the MOU with the SWCD and NEORSD for the provision of the Services for an annual disbursement by the City to SWCD in an amount not to exceed Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000), as appropriated by this Council, for each of the years 2021 through 2025, which amount will be reimbursed by NEORSD upon an application thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council authorizes the City to enter into the MOU for the provision of the Services, as set forth in the recitals to this Resolution, for a term beginning January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2025 in an amount not to exceed \$6,000 annually, as appropriated by the this Council, which amount will be reimbursed by NEORSD, upon application thereto, as set forth in the MOU.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal

action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


