The ZBA will convene to consider the application for a variance that would allow for a zoning change for the former Macy's property at Richmond Town Square to be used as an indoor storage facility. Variances for Dollar General, prospective purchaser of the property at 26180 Chardon Road, will also be considered during the meeting.
