This was the first undefeated conference season since the 2012-2013, which is the last time Richmond Heights won the Chagrin Valley Conference. ## Cuyahoga County Airport Construction Update

On April 2, the Cuyahoga County Airport will begin the final two phases of the Runway 6/24 Safety Area Program. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) provided enough funds to complete both Phase 3 and 4 in the same construction season. The project will begin on April 2 and should be completed by mid-September 2018. The construction costs for these phases are \$11,648,703, with FAA funding 90%, ODOT 5%, and the County funding the remaining 5%. Please expect an increase in truck traffic down Curtiss-Wright and traveling north down Richmond Road.
