Richmond Town Square

Preliminary plans have been presented to the city for the development of approximately 22 acres at the northern end of Richmond Town Square. The project, as presented by developer Dealpoint Merrill, could include as many as 375 apartment units, retail space, a small hotel, parking and green space and would require demolition of the vacant former Sears department store and use of the surrounding parking lot. Total cost of the project is estimated to be \$69 million. A zoning amendment to allow for planning a mixed use development on the site will be considered by the Planning Commission and City Council this month. Over the next few months the city will be carefully reviewing site plans, design, parking and other amenities associated with the project.
