Kiwanis Lodge Improvements

The city was recently awarded a Municipal Grant Award for \$150,000 through the Cuyahoga County Department of Development's 2018 Municipal Grant Program. Richmond Heights was one of 12 suburbs in Cuyahoga County to receive a grant award. The Municipal Grant Award funds will be used to make further improvements to the lower level event space at the city's Kiwanis Lodge. This follows a \$50,000 grant award received from Cuyahoga County which funded the construction of a ramp that now provides access to the lower level of the Kiwanis Lodge for those with mobility impairment.
