

**RESOLUTION NO.:** 69-2023  
**INTRODUCED BY:** Mayor and All of Council

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A “BODY WORN CAMERA GRANT”  
AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXPEND SAID GRANT FUNDS  
BY ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT WITH CHAGRIN VALLEY  
DISPATCH FOR THE PURCHASE OF SEVENTEEN (17) BODY WORN  
CAMERAS FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE.**

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a grant from the Body Worn Camera Grant Program 2023 (the “Grant”) through the Office of Criminal Justice Services, the State of Ohio’s administering agency for the Family Violence Prevention and Services Act and the STOP Violence Against Women federal grant programs, in the amount of \$34,270.00 for the purchase of body worn cameras for the Division of Police;

WHEREAS, the City has received a quotation from Chagrin Valley Dispatch for the purchase of seventeen (17) body worn cameras in the amount of \$34,270.00, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the requirement for competitive bidding is waived under the City’s Charter where the quotation from Chagrin Valley Dispatch is below pricing available from the state’s cooperative purchasing program for such supplies upon equivalent terms, conditions, and specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to accept the Grant set forth in the preamble to this Resolution on behalf of the City and is authorized to execute all instruments necessary to receive the Grant funds.


Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to expend the Grant funds by entering into a contract with the Chagrin Valley Dispatch for the purchase of seventeen (17) body worn cameras for the Division of Police as set forth in the quotation attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


