A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH JAN-PRO FOR OFFICE CLEANING SERVICES FOR THE CITY'S POLICE STATION.

WHEREAS, JAN-PRO has provided office cleaning services for the Richmond Heights Police Station at 27201 Highland Road for a one-year term ending June 30, 2023, for an amount not to exceed Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$14,742.00);

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has obtained a quote from JAN-PRO to continue said services for a one-year term at the same price;

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with JAN-PRO for office cleaning services for the Richmond Heights Police Station for a one-year term in an amount not to exceed Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$14,742.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with JAN-PRO for office cleaning services for the Richmond Heights Police Station at 27201 Highland Road for a one-year term for a cost not to exceed Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$14,742.00).

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to utilize General Fund #100 for the cost of the agreement authorized in Section 1.


