A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WEST ROOFING SYSTEMS, INC. FOR THE POLICE STATION ROOF REPLACEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City has received a proposal from West Roofing Systems, Inc. for the Police Station Roof Replacement Project under State Term Schedule Contract #800897 pricing in the amount of \$242,812 for the replacement of the roof and fascia;

WHEREAS, given the type and age of the subject roof, it has been requested by the administration that this authorization include a twenty percent (20%) contingency for unknown conditions of the current roof that may be discovered during the work and need repair;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with West Roofing Systems, Inc. for the Police Station Roof Replacement Project in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$242,812.00), plus a contingency amount of twenty percent (20%) for currently unknown conditions that may necessitate repair or replacement.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to appropriate funds from the Local Fiscal Recovery/ARPA Fund No. 221 for the cost of the contract authorized in Section 1.




Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
