

RESOLUTION NO.: 161 -2023

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AN OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT AND AUTHORIZING MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE CITY.

WHEREAS, through the efforts of the Division of Fire, the City has been awarded an Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation "Safety Intervention Grant" in the amount of \$27,293.59 for the purpose of purchasing a LUCAS Automatic Chest Compression System and a Powered Stair Chair for the the City's Division of Fire rescue squads to replace equipment which is at the end of its useful life for certification, service and support purposes;

WHEREAS, the Grant requires a match by the City of \$9,097.86 for a total program amount for the specified purchases of \$36,391.45.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to accept the Grant set forth in the preamble to this Resolution on behalf of the City and is authorized to take all actions necessary to accept the Grant, which includes the City's commitment to the required matching amount of \$9,097.86 for this Grant.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is directed to appropriate funds from Fund No. 233-1300-54500 for the payment of the matching amount set forth in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
