

RESOLUTION NO.: 32-2024

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRADE-IN OF POLICE VEHICLES UNNEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE SIMULTANEOUSLY WITH THE PURCHASE OF NEW VEHICLES FROM MONTROSE FORD.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code § 721.15 authorizes this Council to adopt a resolution to authorize the sale of obsolete, unneeded, or unfit vehicles, equipment, or machinery simultaneously with the purchase of the new vehicles, equipment, or machinery of similar type and to have the selling price credited against the purchase price of other vehicles, equipment, or machinery;

WHEREAS, this Council previously authorized the purchase of two (2) 2023 Ford Police Interceptors from Montrose Ford by Resolution No. 158-2023, passed by this Council on November 28, 2023, and the purchase of three (3) 2023 Ford Police Interceptors from Montrose Ford by Resolution No. 11-2024, passed by this Council on January 23, 2024;

WHEREAS, the City has received buyer's order forms from Montrose Ford, attached hereto as Exhibit A, to credit the sale of four vehicles no longer needed for the City's use as trade-in credits against the price of the five (5) Ford Police Interceptors previously authorized by Council to be purchased from Montrose Ford;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The following vehicles are determined not to be needed for public use, and/or are obsolete or unfit for the use for which they were acquired and may be traded in for credit against the price of five (5) Ford Police Interceptors from Montrose Ford, the purchase of which was previously authorized by resolutions of this Council:


2013 Honda Fit - VIN# JHMGE8H38DC079322	\$1,500.00 credit
2018 Ford Explorer - VIN# 1FM5K8AR5JGC18788	\$9,000.00 credit
2021 Chevrolet Tahoe - VIN# 1GNSKLED1MR387957	\$30,000.00 credit
2021 Chevrolet Tahoe - VIN# 1GNSKLEDXMR387858	\$30,000.00 credit.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


