A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT WITH PC ALTERNATIVES, LLC FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT SERVICES FOR THE CITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 18-2022, passed by this Council on February 22, 2022, the City entered into an agreement with PC Alternatives, LLC of Richmond Heights, Ohio, for information technology support services for a term of one (1) year, from January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022 (the "Agreement");

WHEREAS, that Agreement was renewed for the period of January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023, as authorized by Resolution No. 14-2023, passed by this Council on February 14, 2023;

WHEREAS, continuing information technology support services are necessary for the operation and maintenance of the City's information technology system and facilities;

WHEREAS, PC Alternatives has served the City's information technology, video recording and telecommunications needs for several years and has provided reliable service and is familiar with the City's information technology equipment and has agreed to continue to perform such services under the same terms as the Agreement entered into in 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an extension of the Agreement with PC Alternatives, LLC executed in 2022 and as extended and amended in 2023 for information technology support services for a term of one (1) additional year to commence as of January 1, 2024, and continue through December 31, 2024, in an amount that shall not exceed \$20,000.00 without further authorization from this Council.

Section 2: The funds required for the expense in Section 1 of this Resolution shall come from the General Fund No. 100-7150-52400.


