A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF UNNEEDED CITY
VEHICLES THROUGH AN INTERNET AUCTION BY GOVDEALS.COM,
INC.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code § 721.15 authorizes this Council to adopt a resolution to authorize the sale by internet auction of personal property owned by the City, including personal property items referenced in R.C. § 721.15, which are no longer needed for public use or are obsolete or unfit for the use for which they were acquired, and this Council adopted Resolution No. 7-2024, on January 23, 2024, to authorize internet auction sales during 2024, as required by R.C. § 721.15;

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has requested to sell certain City vehicles that are unneeded, obsolete and/or unfit for the use for which they were acquired, through an internet auction to be administered by GovDeals.Com, Inc;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The following items of personal property are determined not to be needed for public use, and/or are obsolete or unfit for the use for which they were acquired and may be sold through an internet auction procedure by GovDeals.com, Inc.:

2001 International Plow/Dump Truck
VIN # 1HTSDAAN01H343717
(Mileage of 63,298 Miles)

2004 Chevrolet Pickup Truck
VIN # 2GCEK19N541338265
(Mileage of 119,670 Miles)

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
