A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF DIVISION OF FIRE VEHICLE INVENTORY CONSISTING OF A YEAR 2000 AMERICAN LAFRANCE QUINT LADDER TRUCK FOR TRADE-IN ALLOWANCE/CREDIT WITH AUBURN CAREER CENTER TRAINING GROUNDS FOR FIREFIGHTER TRAINING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Division of Fire has recently taken delivery of a new Sutphen Aerial Ladder truck and desires to trade in its year 2000 American LaFrance Quint ladder truck which has been replaced in exchange for a credit with Auburn Career Center for the cost of firefighter training services;

WHEREAS, Auburn Career Center has offered a trade-in value of \$20,000 for the used ladder truck in the form of a credit of \$20,000 to be expended toward use of its facilities, including live burning building, instructors, and fire service curricula for firefighter training services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to execute all documents necessary to transfer ownership of the following vehicle to Auburn Career Center in exchange for a credit of \$20,000 for firefighter training services for the Division of Fire at its facility:




Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
