A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A COMMUNITY COST-SHARE AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT FOR FUNDING OF A COMMUNITY COST-SHARE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 13-2016, passed April 12, 2016, the City of Richmond Heights entered into a Regional Stormwater Management Program Service Agreement with Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (“NEORS” or the “District”);

WHEREAS, as part of the Regional Stormwater Management Program, NEORS manages a Community Cost Share Program which provides funding to assist the City with District-approved projects;

WHEREAS, the District has approved the City’s application for reimbursement for the cost of purchasing a mini-excavator and trailer to utilize for catch basin, retention pond and culvert maintenance work in the amount of \$109,990.00, as a Community Cost Share project, and the District will allocate the total sum of \$109,990.00 in Community Cost Share funds for this project;

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into a Community Cost-Share Agreement with NEORS so that Community Cost-Share funds can be utilized for the City’s project described above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into a Community Cost-Share Agreement with NEORS to receive the sum of \$109,990.00 to reimburse the City for the cost of a mini-excavator and trailer for the City’s Community Cost Share project.


Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


