

RESOLUTION NO: 1-2025

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT BY THE MAYOR OF RUDOLPH HILLIARD AS COMMISSIONER OF THE DIVISION OF BUILDING, ZONING, AND HOUSING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 4(E), of the Charter of the City of Richmond Heights provides that the Mayor shall appoint the Commissioner of the Division of Building, Zoning and Housing, with the approval of Council;

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Rudolph Hilliard as Commissioner of the Division of Building, Zoning and Housing to be effective January 15, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: This Council hereby approves the Mayor's appointment of Rudolph Hilliard as Commissioner of Building, Zoning and Housing to be effective January 15,, 2025.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide continuing public services in the Division of Building, Zoning and Housing; therefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of five members of the Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
