A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE OR OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH IT WAS ACQUIRED.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code § 721.15 requires this Council to adopt a resolution when the City wishes to authorize the discarding or salvage of municipal personal property that is no longer needed for public use or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired where this Council has determined that such property has no value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The following items of personal property are determined not to be needed for public use and/or are obsolete or unfit for the use for which they were acquired and to have no value and may be discarded or salvaged:
