

RESOLUTION NO.: 94-2025

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RICHMOND-CHARDON
STREETSCAPE AND BUSINESS REVITALIZATION PLAN.**

WHEREAS, the past decade has drastically shifted the economic, business, and social characteristics of the business districts along Richmond and Chardon Roads in Richmond Heights;

WHEREAS, while these changes have presented challenges to the City of Richmond Heights, its residents, and its businesses, they have also created opportunities to build resilient and vibrant economic hubs that enhance the social, economic, and environmental health of surrounding neighborhoods and the City as a whole;

WHEREAS, recognizing this opportunity, the City of Richmond Heights applied for and received a Community Planning Grant from the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission in 2024, which Grant provides 95% of all costs associated with professional planning services and costs associated with what has been produced as the “Richmond-Chardon Streetscape and Business Revitalization Plan” (the “Plan”) that is available to the public from the Clerk of Council;

WHEREAS, this Council has reviewed the Plan and wholeheartedly endorses the Plan as furthering the goals set forth therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council hereby adopts the “Richmond-Chardon Streetscape and Business Revitalization Plan” and its implementation.

Section 2: All formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were had in compliance with the law, including R.C. Section 121.22.


Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
