

RESOLUTION NO.: 140-2025
INTRODUCED BY MAYOR THOMAS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH VERDANTAS TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES (TASK ORDER #10) FOR THE RICHMOND HEIGHTS CITY HALL STREAMBANK STABILIZATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Verdantas has proposed to provide professional engineering design and construction services for the Richmond Heights City Hall Streambank Stabilization Project (the "Project") as provided in its Task Order No. 10, generally under the terms of the Master Agreement for Professional Consulting Services between the City and Verdantas dated March 12, 2025, for compensation on the basis of lump sum fees set forth in Task Order No. 10 for a total amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$155,000.00);

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize an agreement with Verdantas for such professional engineering design and construction services for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Verdantas for professional engineering design and construction services for the Project as set forth in Task Order No. 10, attached hereto as Exhibit A, for an amount not to exceed \$155,000.00.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to utilize funds in Fund No. 450-5450-52107 for the cost of the Agreement authorized in Section 1 above.



Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



Verdantas is pleased to submit for your consideration this proposal to provide Engineering Design Services to the City of Richmond Heights. The following will confirm our understanding of the project and the scope of our services.

The Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORS) has identified a reach of Claribel Creek with significant erosion adjacent to the Richmond Heights City Hall building. It is Verdantas understanding that NEORS has committed to funding \$350,000 for the design and construction of this project. Verdantas is scoped to prepare design, procurement, and construction administration along this reach of channel (approximately 300 L.F.).

SCOPE OF SERVICES

- ▶ Task 1 – Field Study and Survey
 - Limited Property Line Establishment
 - Existing Conditions Survey, including Ohio 811 and Utility locating
- ▶ Task 2 – Geotechnical Investigation
 - Field Investigation and Sampling
 - Laboratory Testing
 - Engineering Analysis, Recommendations and Report Preparation
- ▶ Task 3 – Permitting
 - Wetland and stream delineation of existing surface water features
 - Coordination with USFWS, ODNR, regarding listed species
 - Coordination with SHPO regarding historic properties and cultural resources
 - Preparation of USACE Pre-Construction Notification and Nationwide Permit Application

Permitting application submittal	2 weeks from completion of 60% design
Final Drawings	8-12 weeks

PROJECT BUDGET

We will accomplish the work outlined in the Scope of Services for the completion of the subject project in accordance with the Master Service Agreement. Compensation for the proposal services shall be a Lump Sum Fee.

Fee is subject to adjustment based on actual field conditions identified during the field study and survey activities or due to Client requested changes, however, the identified budget is not to be exceeded without further authorization. Any changes from the proposed Tasks will require a change in authorized fee, whether such change increases or decreases the total proposed fee.
