

RESOLUTION NO.: 154-2025

INTRODUCED BY: Mayor and All of Council

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FROM THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS FOR A PROJECT TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR ITS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026.

WHEREAS, the City has been advised by the Cuyahoga County Department of Development that it is eligible to participate in a competitive application process for awarding of Community Development Supplemental Grant Program funds for Fiscal Year 2026;

WHEREAS, the City is permitted to submit one or more projects as part of its application for the Supplemental Grant Program, provided the aggregate total of the funding does not exceed \$50,000;

WHEREAS, the Grant encourages the City to make a local match to the Grant in the form of direct monetary payments and/or in-kind services for the project(s) and it is determined by this Council that a required City match to the Grant through a direct monetary payment and/or in-kind services will be made;

WHEREAS, a public hearing related to the City's participation in the Community Development Supplemental Grant Program for Fiscal Year 2026 was held by the City on October 28, 2025;

WHEREAS, the City has determined to apply for \$50,000 in said block grant funds to supplement the expenses to resurface and transform four deteriorated outdoor tennis courts at the Richmond Heights Community Center into two regulation tennis courts and six pickleball courts (the "Richmond Heights Community Center Park Court Renewal Project").

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The following project to enhance City facilities is hereby designated as approved for use in the application to be submitted by the City in response to the application process undertaken by the Department of Development of Cuyahoga County for Supplemental Grant Program funds:

Richmond Heights Community Center Park Court Renewal Project.

Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to submit the application on behalf of the City to the Department of Development of Cuyahoga County prior to the submission deadline.


Section 3: All formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.


