

RESOLUTION NO.: 155-2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PARTNER AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT FOR THE CITY HALL STABILIZATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6119, generally, and Ohio Revised Code Section 6119.06(G), the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District ("NEORSD") is authorized to contract with political subdivisions to construct, reconstruct, enlarge, improve, maintain, repair, and operate Water Resource Projects;

WHEREAS, NEORSD has determined that it will reimburse the City up to an amount of \$350,000.000 for the City Hall Stabilization Project (the "Project"), for which the City will be responsible for the performance of the engineering design, easement acquisition and construction of the stabilization of the left and right steam banks of an approximate 300-linear foot portion of the Euclid Creek East Branch behind the Richmond Heights City Hall in order to mitigate the erosion as described in the Chagrin River/Lake Erie Direct tributaries Stormwater Master Plan – Euclid Creek Subwatershed Report;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Project is to stabilize the section of Euclid Creek East Branch without increasing erosion along other reaches of the Regional Stormwater System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a Partner Agreement with NEORSD for the Project and to accept reimbursement in an amount up to \$350,000.00 for the design, easement acquisition and construction of the Project.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


