**A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING AUTHORIZATION OF THE CITY
TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT THROUGH THE
OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES'
COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR ONE VEHICLE
FOR USE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE.**

Whereas, Council has heretofore authorized cooperative purchasing through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchase Program; and

Whereas, the Director of Public Service has advised this Council that the Department is in need of one vehicle, a 4-wheel drive truck, the purchase of which can be made through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program for \$25,206.00; and

Whereas, Council's Committee-of-the-Whole has reviewed the need for said vehicle and authorized the procurement of the vehicle through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program from Valley Ford Truck, Inc. in Valley View, Ohio, and this Council desires to confirm said purchase by this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council hereby confirms the authority of the Mayor to enter into a purchase agreement with Valley Ford Truck, Inc., 5715 Canal Road, Valley View, Ohio 44125, for the purchase of one (1) model year 2008 Ford F-250, 4-wheel drive truck, for a total cost not to exceed \$25,206.00 under State Contract No. RS 904407, as part of the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 2: The Finance Director be, and she is hereby, authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of said purchase agreement referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in

compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
