A Resolution Congratulating the Richmond Heights Garden Club On the Occasion of its 40th Anniversary

Whereas the Richmond Heights Garden Club was founded as a result of three of the founders of the Club meeting over coffee to discuss a tragic accident in which a pedestrian was hit by a car on Highland Road losing his life and the founders seeing the need for a bike path to be installed along Highland Road and desiring to form this Club in order to improve and beautify the City of Richmond Heights; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Heights Garden Club became a reality in 1968 and since that time its beautification projects have contributed to the overall beauty of the community-at-large through plantings and landscaping at City Hall, the City Gazebo, the Highland Road City sign and the Highland Road and Richmond Road school signs, and its participation in civic activities and scholarships have improved life in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and all of Council desire to publicly acknowledge this milestone of the Richmond Heights Garden Club and the improvements made to the City through the devotion and hard work of its members.
