

ORDINANCE NO.: 5 -2009

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY PUBLIC BID OF
VEHICLES NO LONGER NEEDED FOR CITY PURPOSES.**

Whereas, the Director of Public Safety and the Chief of Police have recommended the sale of five police vehicles (VIN Nos. 2FAFP71W33X119450, 1FAFP5356WG222466, 2FAFP71WOYX140862, 2FAFP71WX4X136652, and 2FAFP71WO3X175488), of the Division of Police, all of which are either not needed or no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

Whereas, Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for the sale of such unneeded property by authorization of this City Council pursuant to a written contract with the highest and best bidder after advertisement for not less than two nor more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City; and

Whereas, Section 3(c) of Article VI of the Charter places the duty upon the Director of Finance for the acceptance of bids for the disposal of obsolete or surplus equipment as requested by the responsible department head;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the sale of the five Division of Police vehicles identified in the preamble to this Ordinance and, the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to accept such bids and, along with the Mayor/ Director of Public Safety, enter into such written contracts as necessary for the sale of said vehicles to the highest and best bidder or bidders.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
