

ORDINANCE NO.: 60 -2009

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 141 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO ADOPT A NEW SECTION 141.29 AUTHORIZING CERTAIN FEES TO BE CHARGED BY THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Public Safety Committee of this Council that the Division of Police be authorized to charge a fee to persons requesting fingerprinting to be done by the Division of Police and to charge for authorizing the release of a vehicle that has been impounded by the Division of Police since there are time and administrative costs expended by the Division of Police to perform these functions; and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, Cuyahoga County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Chapter 141, "Division of Police", of the Codified Ordinances of the City is amended to add new section 141.29 to read as follows:

"141.29 Fees for Services of Division of Police

The Director of Public Safety is authorized to establish a fee schedule to be charged to persons for the following services and functions provided by the Division of Police:

Fingerprinting requested by an individual; and

Authorization of release of a vehicle impounded by the Division of Police."

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
